FIFTH SUNDAY WORSHIP At Treadwell and Franklin UMC's-

At the request of Jan Rowell I am pleased to share what is done on the Fifth Sundays each year. When I came as pastor to this charge seven years ago the two churches were not one family. I encouraged the churches to meet for joint worship followed by a dish to pass meal at alternate churches on the fifth Sunday's during the year. The host church picked a special mission project which both churches supported in a special offering by bringing specific items or a cash donated. For the fifth Sunday of November 2015 Franklin and Treadwell raised \$245.80 for the work of Seneca Street UMC in Buffalo. The missions chosen have ranged from local needs to conference advance specials to international needs. Since instituting the fifth Sunday joint worship and offerings the two churches have gone from one not paying any ministry shares and the other struggling to pay current and past ministry shares to both paying 100% of ministry shares and doing other mission projects beyond the ministry shares and fifth Sunday worship projects. Nicaragua 2016

A VIM team will be going to Nicaragua in 2016. Tentative dates are March 3—17. The team will be working with Dr. Belinda Forbes, UM missionary dentist. Belinda works with Accion Medica Cristiana (Christian Medical Action/ AMC), an agency that works with some of the poorest people in Nicaragua, the second poorest country in our hemisphere. The team will probably do health related work but not direct medical care. Work might include assisting with dental care, health education, construction, etc. AMC will look at the team's skills and the community's needs to determine the work and the location. It is expected that the team will go to the northeastern region, the RACCN, which is regarded as the poorest area of Nicaragua.

The team is being sponsored by First UMC, Schenectady, which has a covenant relationship with Dr. Forbes. Anticipated cost will be \$2000-2500. Team leader is Cindy Schulte.
