


Social Hour and Lunch to Follow



W2 forms and Affordable Care Act reporting regulations

All local churches must provide W2s to their employees, including pastors employed by the local church, by Jan. 31. For information on local church W2 reporting responsibilities, <u>Click Here.</u>. Please note, religious organizations continue to be exempt from having to list the cost of health insurance on W2s. For W2 samples and instructions, refer to the <u>Church Employer page</u> on the Upper New York Conference website.

Many churches may have recently seen information about the "2015 Internal Revenue Code Section 6056 Reporting - Employer-Provided Health Insurance," including 1094-C and 1095-C reporting requirements. This requirement only applies to applicable large employers; therefore, all of our local churches are exempt from this reporting requirement.
