Boundary Awareness Training for Pastors

This training is mandatory for all pastors under appointment

in the Upper New York Annual Conference.

(This is not the same as Safe Sanctuary Training!)

In our life together, we are called to maintain boundaries as a means of maintaining covenant with each other and with those whom we serve. Understanding these boundaries and strategies to maintain them is important to our ministry together.

Beginning in September 2015, the Upper New York Conference Board of Ordained Ministry is offering Boundary Awareness Training for all clergy under appointment. **This training is mandatory for all pastors in the Upper New York Annual Conference.** The trainings will be led by the Rev. Diane Wheatley, in partnership with the Capital Region Theological Center. Rev. Wheatley is an ordained clergy member of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America.

1) Take steps to prevent further damage to a family's personal property (stabilize):

- o Tarping Debris removal Cleaning out of flooded homes
- 2. Teams may be asked to manage donated materials, gather information or other perform other tasks as deemed necessary by the community.
- 3. Observe survivor's needs and report these to the local operations.
- 4. Be a part of the caring ministry of "listeners" who will help the survivor being to heal.
