Provide a Christian presence. This does not sound like a task... and is NOT, however, it can be the MOST important thing a team can do.

- 1) Take steps to prevent further damage to a family's personal property (stabilize):
  - o Tarping Debris removal Cleaning out of flooded homes
- 2. Teams may be asked to manage donated materials, gather information or other perform other tasks as deemed necessary by the community.
- 3. Observe survivor's needs and report these to the local operations.
- 4. Be a part of the caring ministry of "listeners" who will help the survivor being to heal.
