Unadilla's 'The Village Green" Group, in partnership with Unadilla 1st United Methodist Church, has scheduled a COMMUNITY WORKDAY AND TREE PLANTING CEREMONY this Saturday, November 14th from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm at the United Methodist Church and Parsonage, across from the Great American on Main St in Unadilla. The Community Workday this Saturday will allow neighbors to pitch in at the ground level of establishing this community food forest as we are clearing brush, laying out and preparing initial beds and paths, and spreading sheet mulch prior to the first snows of winter. Participants, both young and old, will have an opportunity to learn a bit about the ecological dynamics of our local forests and how those dynamics can be used to design sustainable gardens, public spaces, and food systems in our own backyards and communities. Forest Gardening is a gardening system that mimics a natural woodland environment that is self-watering, self-weeding, self-mulching, self-fertilizing and highly productive. The Workday will culminate in a Fruit Tree Planting Ceremony to be held at 2:00pm, symbolizing the first seed of this exciting community project. Lunch, snacks and hot drinks will be provided.

Nicaragua 2016

A VIM team will be going to Nicaragua in 2016. Tentative dates are March 3—17. The team will be working with Dr. Belinda Forbes, UM missionary dentist. Belinda works with Accion Medica Cristiana (Christian Medical Action/ AMC), an agency that works with some of the poorest people in Nicaragua, the second poorest country in our hemisphere. The team will probably do health related work but not direct medical care. Work might include assisting with dental care, health education, construction, etc. AMC will look at the team's skills and the community's needs to determine the work and the location. It is expected that the team will go to the northeastern region, the RACCN, which is regarded as the poorest area of Nicaragua.

The team is being sponsored by First UMC, Schenectady, which has a covenant relationship with Dr. Forbes. Anticipated cost will be \$2000-2500. Team leader is Cindy Schulte.
